The Canadian Union of Postal Workers (CUPW) national strike came into effect Friday, November 15th at 12:01am ET. For the duration of the strike, Financial Services will continue to print cheques as scheduled, however, cheques will not be mailed until Canada Post resumes normal service.

## **Payroll Cheques**

Please contact <u>Central Payroll Services</u> to arrange for cheque pick-up.

- Payroll cheques can be picked up Monday to Friday, during regular business hours at 215 Huron St, 8th Floor.
- Payroll cheques can only be picked up by the individuals whose names are on the cheques.
- Please bring your ID for identification purposes.

## **Vendor Cheques**

Please contact FSD Accounts Payable to arrange department cheque pick up.

- Cheque pick up will be available Monday to Thursday, during regular business hours at 215 Huron St, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor.
- Cheques can only be picked up by UofT employees.
  - Do *not* arrive for pick up until you have been notified that your cheque is ready.
  - Do not send vendors to pick up cheques.

Wires payments will only be considered in very limited circumstances.

Note: These are temporary measures only for the duration of the Canada Post strike.

We highly encourage setting up <u>EFT</u> to avoid payment delays caused by future mail service disruptions. For low dollar value invoices, consider paying with P-Card.
